This series is called, 'I've been meaning to ask...' Here is a little bit more about the theme from *A Sanctified Art*: "Our leading question, "I've been meaning to ask..." conveys intentionality, warmth, curiosity, and consideration. The main objective of this series is to cultivate courageous conversations – and to keep having them, even if we need to pause. The questions are not surface level; they invite us to share our pain and seek ways to care for one another. We pray that through vulnerability and authenticity these conversations lead us to glimpse hope, joy, and beauty." This series will shape our worship, devotional life, faith formation activities, and ways that we connect with one another

Special "busy bags" will be available for worship with interactive worship activities for children that directly relate to the liturgy and theme each Sunday. Updated 9/10/21

Information around the COVID-19 pandemic changes almost daily. As the Delta variant circulates through our global and local communities, our Covid-19 Task Force continues to monitor numbers closely and faithfully makes decisions and policies for our faith community. As a community organization, we have an obligation to protect our youngest members who are not yet eligible for the vaccine. In all of our decisions, we work hard to live out our Christian calling to love and protect our neighbors.

As such, the current Valley of Peace Covid-19 protocol states that all people regardless of vaccination status are required to wear face masks in indoor spaces at Valley of Peace. Additionally, we are asking any person over the age of 2 to mask outside when participating in children and youth programming, pre-K through high school, regardless of vaccination status. The COVID Task Force will revisit these policies as we continue to monitor data and what other congregations and organizations in our local community are doing.
