APRIL MISSION OF THE MONTH: LOAVES AND FISHES

As far back as the 1980's, VoP has had volunteers working with Loaves & Fishes in various capacities. These included meal planning, shopping, cooking, serving, and cleaning up. Folks began in the morning and worked till 7 PM to get it all done. Today this job is greatly simplified and planned by an L&F staff person.

Needing Volunteers:

Where - Brunswick United Methodist Church, 42nd Ave, west of Hwy 100.

When - One Wednesday afternoon/evening a month 4 PM - 6:30 PM.

To do - Meal prep, chop vegetables, make salads, clean fruit, prepare and fill take-out containers. These are then taken outside to the waiting vehicle of the guests, who simply drive up and indicate the number of meals needed.

We are currently serving 60 to 85 meals on the second Wednesday of each month with a team of 3 or 4 people. We would like to expand our service to an additional Wednesday each month. 

Psychological First Aid

Psychological First Aid (PFA) is an evidence-informed 2-hour virtual training for all community members and professionals. Trainees will learn how to support healthy recovery in individuals following a traumatic event, public health emergency, natural disaster, or personal crisis. The curriculum integrates public health, community health and individual psychology by drawing upon skills the trainees already have. The goal of PFA is to teach trainees how to reduce distress and negative health behaviors by providing practical help and promoting resilience. CEU's are available.

Participants will learn:

- The impact traumatic experiences can have on individuals, and how burnout may impact frontline staff and first responders.
- The five pillars of the PFA framework and how to apply them to support someone who has experienced a traumatic event.
- How to recognize when an individual should be referred to a mental health professional.

Who should attend?

Anyone can attend! This training is for community members or professionals, including community volunteers, frontline staff, nonprofit workers, direct service staff, community health workers and other professionals.

The Minneapolis Area Synod and Faith+Lead are beginning a new pilot partnership!

Faith+Lead is offering free access to its online courses, monthly workshops, group coaching calls, and more, to all leaders and members that are part of the Minneapolis Area Synod!



These courses and workshops can be used for personal study and growth, small group curriculum, or even larger group use like a forum or education hour. You can sign up for a Faith+Lead membership through the Minneapolis Area Synod if you are a church member, visitor, questioner, volunteer, pastor, deacon, or staff member -- anyone who has a connection with the Synod or a congregation in the synod.

This partnership between the Minneapolis Area Synod and Faith+Lead is a pilot project designed to connect more people with the great resources Faith+Lead has to offer and give users an opportunity to provide feedback on Faith+Lead's systems and courses. Participants may occasionally be asked to respond to questions or surveys from the Synod and/or Faith+Lead.
