^{*}Response to Request for Proposal (RFP) pre bid walk through on Tuesday was outstanding.

^{*}Five of the Six General Contractors (G C's) invited participated. The GC's brought along a number of sub-contractors with specialties in electrical, mechanical and plumbing. We had about 30 people checking out everything from power panels in the boiler room to exhaust vents on the flat roof tops!

^{*}A number of questions were asked of our Architect to which they will be responding. Any additional questions or site visits will take place by Aug, 21st.

^{*}RFP responses and proposals by interested G C's are due by August 28th.

^{*}If the response to the initial walk through is an indication there appears to be real interest in VoP's Lower Level Improvement project.
