

Why it matters: this Minneapolis story has metro-wide resonance—how our region's past is woven into the houses, streets, and systems that shaped today's suburbs, and how those histories inform ongoing conversations about belonging and equity in our community.

#### **MISSION STATEMENT**

We believe we are all created in God's image and that we are called by Jesus, through the workings of the Holy Spirit for healing, justice, and peace, to reconciliation, service, and care for all of God's beloved community.
