As we enter the winter months, we want to be sure everyone stays safe and informed when weather impacts our gatherings at Valley of Peace.

#### **Sunday Worship**

If winter weather makes travel unsafe for Sunday worship, information about cancellations or schedule changes will be shared on our Valley of Peace Facebook Page and sent by e-mail to all congregation members. We will also make every effort to post closing information on KARE 11. There will be a worship service shared on our YouTube page and this information will be shared in the e-mail.

#### Weekday Office Hours & Programming

During the week, Valley of Peace follows the weather policy of All God's Children Discovery Center (AGC), which follows the Robbinsdale School District for weather closings.

If Robbinsdale closes due to winter weather, AGC and Valley of Peace will also close. This also means that all church related meetings and activities are cancelled for the entire day and evening.

On extremely cold days, when Robbinsdale closes, AGC will open with a two-hour delay, and Valley of Peace staff and office hours will follow that schedule as well.

#### YOUTH CHRISTMAS PARTY





# December 7 – Study of the Book of Revelation (Part 4) Laurie Eaton With the opening of the seven seals in Revelation 6, we enter some of the toughest terrain of the entire book – the terrifying middle chapters (Revelation 6-18). We'll explore how to approach the images created by the opening of the first six seals. To reach the hope at the end of the journey in Revelation, we must first experience great conflict and judgment. Like an urgent wake-up call, the visions of the opening of the seals deliver God's diagnosis of the evils of the Roman Empire. They also give the assurance that the empire's reign of violence soon will come to an end. These visions speak to us today, helping to unveil the toxic aspects of our own culture. The good news is that the witness of God's people truly makes a difference. God hears the cries of all victims who suffer, and God


